Outcome Measures

Data Collection Instructions:

Eligibility criteria: Collect data from maternal deliveries discharged to home.

The goal is to review a sample of 20 deliveries a month.

- Example 1: If your hospital has 100 deliveries discharged in a month, then divide 100 by 20=5 and you will select every 5th maternal discharge for that month.
- Example 2: If your hospital has 35 deliveries discharged in a month, then 35 divided by 20 is 1.75 and you will select every 2nd maternal discharge for that month.
